

Ster-Kinekor to retrench more than 200 employees

Just two years after exiting business rescue, Ster-Kinekor plans to lay off 236 employees, approximately 32% of its workforce, and shut down up to nine cinemas in Gauteng, KwaZulu-Natal, and the Western Cape.

This comes after <u>challenges</u> such as a tough economic climate, load-shedding, financial constraints, and delays in movie releases due to Hollywood strikes which led to decreased cinema attendance and revenue.

The nine cinema locations earmarked for closure:

- Bayside (WC)
- Boardwalk (KZN)
- Mimosa (KZN)
- Shelly Beach (KZN)
- Cedar Square (GP)
- Maponya (GP)
- Matlosana (GP)
- Southgate (GP)
- Sterland (GP)

This news comes during a <u>climate</u> where streaming services such as Netflix, Disney and Amazon Prime have become more popular for blockbusters, ultimately affecting cinema numbers.
