

# Boschendal wines awarded spots on Sommelier Selection 2016 wine list

Three wines from one of South Africa's iconic wine farms, [Boschendal](#), has been chosen for inclusion on the Sommelier Selection 2016 wine list, announced at the Sommelier Selection Awards ceremony on 26 July 2016.



Judged and selected by South Africa's top sommeliers, 90 wines from a short-list of 500 were chosen to make up a final list that will be shared and recommended with SA's top dining establishments around the country.

This unique South African wine competition is judged solely by a panel of Sommeliers who blind taste each wine. The Sommeliers on the panel all have extensive judging and work experience as well as an in-depth knowledge of international and local markets of what consumers are looking for in their drinking or food pairing wine preferences.
