

Soweto Sexpo postponed to September

The Soweto Sex & Wellness Expo (Sexpo) 2018 will no longer be held in May and has been rescheduled to take place at a larger venue in September. The Sexpo is a sexual lifestyle event, aimed at promoting sexual wellness through an open environment.

According to a spokesperson for the organisers, Gabriel Ramokotjo, "The ticket sales have exceeded the capacity of the original venue. Therefore, in the interests of visitor comfort, we have decided to postpone the event to spring once we have secured a bigger venue."
